HLT43907 to HLT40213 Transition Program

About the Course

With the introduction of registration for Aboriginal Health Practitioners, the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) introduced a grand parenting provision. This allowed individuals who had completed the previous qualification (HLT43907 Certificate IV in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care (Practice)) to register as an Aboriginal Health Practitioner with AHPRA. The grand parenting provision has now ended and anyone who holds the HLT43907 qualification and did not register with AHPRA during this time is unable to register with their existing qualification.

Individuals who wish to upgrade to the current qualification are encouraged to submit an application for the HLT40213 Certificate IV in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care Practice qualification, noting on their application their current qualification held. If successful in their application, students are then encouraged to consider which units of competency they may be eligible for recognition for and submit a recognition application accordingly.
