About Our Elder Care support roles

As an **Elder Care Support Connector**, you'll work with your community and your Elder Care Support Coordinator to help Elders and older people, their families, and carers to access the aged care services they are entitled to. You'll build trusting connections with people to help arrange and organise the appropriate support they need. You'll also plan community events and activities to help everyone know more about the aged care services available to stay well.

As an **Elder Care Support Coordinator**, you'll receive the training and ongoing support to develop the knowledge you need to navigate the aged care system. Working closely with our Elder Care Support Connector, you'll enable Elders and older people to access appropriate local aged care support services. You'll help clients and their families understand their aged care service entitlements, registration and costs, and liaise with aged care assessors to ensure Elders are well-supported throughout the assessment process.

No qualification is required for these roles, however a qualification in community services and Aboriginal mental health first aid would be valuable.
