

Sexual Health – Tailored Support Packages

The Sexual Health and BBV Program offer a flexible and tailored approach to STI screening through the development of tailored supports for sexual health programs. These are designed to meet the specific needs and context of your service and community, providing targeted and sustainable support to promote STI screening in everyday practice, and enhanced community-wide screening periods if your service would like to continue this model.



Education & Support For Staff

Our team is available to provide ongoing education and tailored support for health services to respond to sexual health issues (including blood-borne viruses) in your community. We offer training sessions and workshops to strengthen your team's confidence in offering and conducting opportunistic STI screening, follow-up, and patient support related to sexual health. In addition, we can provide education on healthy relationships, sexuality, and gender diversity to promote a more inclusive approach to sexual health care. We can also provide support for Point-of-Care Testing (POCT) to help your team provide accessible testing options.

Support for Community Events

We can support community events, including health days (stalls), women's and men's groups, and school programs. By working together with your service, we can develop informative and engaging activities that provide sexual health information in an accessible and culturally relevant way.

Assistance for Early-Career Aboriginal Health Practitioners

Our team offers mentorship, training, and support to early-career Aboriginal Health Practitioners, helping to build their skills and confidence in delivering sexual health care to their communities.



Health Promotion Resource Support

We can work with your team to co-design and develop health promotion resources tailored to your community's needs. From concept to final product, we can work collaboratively to develop resources that are relevant, engaging, and useful for the people you work with.

Data and Communicare Support

Whichever data program(s) your service participates in, we are available to work with you to analyse screening, follow-up, and positivity data to support surveillance and CQI priorities. We can also assist services with setting recalls for screening periods, as well as support for using ATLAS data, including the ATLAS dashboard.

Enhanced Screening Support

Although we are no longer coordinating a statewide 6-week enhanced screening period, we are available to support services that wish to continue this model by providing resources, worker education, and community engagement.
