Skin sores or sore throat?
Visit your local health service.

Diphtheria can make you very ill and may even put you in the hospital. It can spread easily between people if it's not treated.

It is important children have all their vaccines as soon as they're due. Be sure to check if you and your families vaccinations are up-to-date.

What else can you do? Make sure you cover coughs and sneezed. Keep wounds clean and covered. Clean household items and surfaces.
